WHEREAS: Cooperatives have contributed greatly to this quality of life, serving as instruments for people to work together; and

WHEREAS: Cooperatives serve farmers and consumers alike in the processing and marketing of products, and provide a wide range of services; and

WHEREAS: By providing jobs, capital investments, competitive prices, quality control and new product development, and by returning earnings to local owner/members, these cooperative businesses contribute substantially to our economic and social development;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October, 1988, to be

CO-OP MONTH

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I urge citizens to recognize the economic and democratic values of cooperatives as they "Build A Better America."
