WHEREAS: The success of our democracy is dependent on the continuing education of our citizenry; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's economy, government, and society demand an increasingly well-educated, well-trained work force; and

WHEREAS: A significant number of our Minnesota citizens have come together to form Dollars for Scholars Chapters to help their local students attend colleges, universities and vocational schools of their choice; and

WHEREAS: These Minnesota cities have volunteered thousands of hours of their time to organize, raise funds, distribute scholarships, and counsel and encourage students; and

WHEREAS: The ninety-two Minnesota Dollars for Scholars Chapters represent the largest number of chapters in any state in the nation; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is the home of the national headquarters of Citizens' Scholarship Foundation of America, Inc., the parent organization of Dollars for Scholars;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 23, 1988, to be

DOLLARS FOR SCHOLARS DAY

in Minnesota.
