WHEREAS: The Hibbing High School Band continues a long tradition of musical excellence and performed as musical goodwill ambassadors spreading the name and fame of Minnesota throughout this nation and the world; and

WHEREAS: The Hibbing High School Band carried the banner of the State of Minnesota abroad to an event which attracted worldwide attention;
