WHEREAS: The first Builders Exchange in the City of Minneapolis and the State of Minnesota was incorporated September 1, 1888; and

WHEREAS: This Minnesota non-profit corporation has processed plans and specifications for most major building construction that has occurred in the area; and

WHEREAS: The Minneapolis Builders Exchange has contributed to the advancement of the building industry and the growth and progress of the City of Minneapolis and the State of Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, October 21, 1988 to be
