The Annual Parents' Communication Network Resource Workshop is being held in Apple Valley on Saturday, October 15; and WHEREAS:

The Parents' Communication Network of Minnesota was chosen as one of the twenty exemplary programs to prevent alcohol and other drug problems across the nation by the National Association of State Alcohol and Drug Abuse Directors and the National Prevention Network in the spring of 1987; and WHEREAS:

The Parents' Communication Network (PCN) of Minnesota is an organization of concerned parents who support each other in discouraging the illegal use and abuse of drugs and WHEREAS:
