

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS: October 12, 1988 marks the 70th anniversary of the Moose Lake-Cloquet Fire; and

WHEREAS: This blaze claimed the lives of hundreds of people, left 13,000 families homeless, and destroyed many communities and thousands of acres of timberland; and

WHEREAS: The tragedy did not diminish the pioneering spirit of the 50,000 settlers in north central Minnesota who endured and were able to rebuild their lives and communities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 12, 1988 to be

in Minnesota, and as a time of remembrance and honor of those who perished and those who persevered this tragic event in Minnesota's history.
