WHEREAS: Construction on the Winona County Courthouse began in 1888; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Winona County, through referendum action in 1971, directed the County Board of Commissioners to renovate this fine Richardsonian Romanesque structure; and

WHEREAS: The two-million dollar project has successfully preserved this historic structure for future generations to admire and enjoy; and

WHEREAS: This renovated Courthouse stands as a tribute to Charles G. Maybury, the well-known Winonan architect, and the citizens of Winona County;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 8, 1988 to be


