

ORDINANCE NO. 71-51

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12.12, SUBDIVISION 5, OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON REGARDING THE SALE AND CONTROL OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, SPECIFICALLY, CREATING AN EXCEPTION ALLOWING "CLUBS," AS DEFINED IN SUBDIVISION 4, PARAGRAPH 4, OF THIS SECTION, TO OPERATE 900 FEET FROM ANY CHURCH.

The City Council of the City of Bloomington ordains:

Section 1. That this ordinance is adopted pursuant to Section 410.31 of the Minnesota Statutes.

Section 2. That Section 12.12, Subdivision 5, of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Bloomington regarding the sale and control of intoxicating liquor is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.12 Intoxicating Liquor.

* * *

Subdivision 5. No "on sale" license shall be granted to any hotel or restaurant for operation on any premises located within 1000 feet of any public school or within 1000 feet of any church; no "on sale" license shall be granted to any club, as defined in this section, for operation on any premises located within 1000 feet of any public school or within 900 feet of any church.

Section 3. The effective date of this ordinance shall be 90 days after its passage and publication.
