

ORDINANCE NO. 71-52

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 12.12, SUBDIVISION 1, OF THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON REGARDING THE SALE AND CONTROL OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR, SPECIFICALLY TO INCLUDE THE TERM "BONA FIDE CLUBS".

The City Council of the City of Bloomington ordains:

Section 1. That this ordinance is adopted pursuant to provisions of Section 410.31 of the Minnesota Statutes.

Section 2. That Section 12.12, Subdivision 1, of the Home Rule Charter of the City of Bloomington regarding the sale and control of intoxicating liquor is hereby amended to read as follows:

12.12. Intoxicating Liquor.

Subdivision 1. The "on sale" of intoxicating liquor in hotels, restaurants, [and] clubs and bona fide clubs within the City of Bloomington is hereby permitted.

Section 3. Effective date. This ordinance shall become effective 90 days after passage and publication.
