ORDINANCE NO. 75-30

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 6.07 AND 6.08 OF THE CITY OF BLOOMINGTON HOME RULE CHARTER AS IT RELATES TO PURCHASES AND CONTRACTS

The City Council of the City of Bloomington ordains:

Section 1. That Section 6.07 of the Bloomington Home Rule Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6.07. Purchases and Contracts by the City Manager. The city manager shall be the chief purchasing agent of the city. Contracts for the purchase of the merchandise, materials, or equipment, if budgeted, or for any kind of construction work [, if budgeted,] may be made or let by the city manager when the amount of such contract does not exceed \$3,000.00. [\$1,000.00. If such contract exceeds the last stated amount but is less than \$2,500.00, same may be made or let by the city manager after first obtaining the approval of the city council.] All other purchases shall be made and all other contracts shall be let by the council. Each contract made by the city manager shall be made or let in conformance with applicable state law and city ordinances.

Section 2. That Section 6.08 of the Bloomington Home Rule Charter is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6.08. Contracts; How Let by the City Council. Every contract for the purchase of merchandise, materials, or equipment or for any kind of construction work where the amount involved is more than \$3,000.00 [\$2,400.00] shall be let only by the council upon the recommendation of the city manager to the lowest responsible bidder, unless [,] the council shall otherwise provide by resolution adopted by a vote of at least five-sevenths of the members of the council and published once in the official legal newspaper of the city. The council may, however, reject any and all bids. Subject to the provisions of the charter, the council may by ordinance adopt further regulations for making of bids and the letting of contracts. Each contract made by the city council shall be made or let in conformance with the state law and city ordinances.
