WHEREAS: The Area Senior Center serves about 300 older adults from Marshall and the surrounding communities; and




NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, October 26, 1988 to be

THE AREA SENIOR CENTER DAY


in Minnesota.
