WHEREAS: An estimated 131,000 children and youth in Minnesota are affected by emotional disturbances; and

WHEREAS: There is a significant gap between the need of mental health services for children and youth and the availability of these services; and

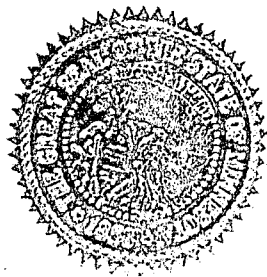
WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has been a leader in advocating for the provision of appropriate mental health services to all persons regardless of age or economic status; and

WHEREAS: A broad spectrum of private, public, and governmental agencies has worked cooperatively to address the mental health service needs of the children and youth of the State;
