

## Proclamation

WHEREAS: An estimated 131,000 children and youth in Minnesota are affected by emotional

disturbances; and

WHEREAS: There is a significant gap between the need of mental health services for children and

youth and the availability of these services; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has been a leader in advocating for the provision of

appropriate mental health services to all persons regardless of age or economic status;

WHEREAS: A broad spectrum of private, public, and governmental agencies has worked cooperatively to address the mental health service needs of the children and youth of the State;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November, 1988 to be

CHILDREN AND YOUTH MENTAL HEALTH MONTH

in Minnesota.
