- WHEREAS: Hopkins residents take great pride in their city as well as the great state they live in — Minnesota;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

### THE CITY OF HOPKINS


to be "Capital for a Day" on November 22, 1988.
