WHEREAS: The Department of Labor and Industry shares in Minnesota's past and present success, and will help Minnesota succeed in the future;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 27, 1988 to be


