

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I,
G. A. Youngquist, attorney general of the state of
Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me
under the provisions of chapter 426, Session Laws
1925, entitled: "An act in relation to the organi-
zation of the state government", approved April 25,
1925, do hereby constitute and appoint LUDVIG
GULLICKSON of Spring Valley, Minnesota, to be an
assistant attorney general of the state of Minnesota
and a member of the rural credit bureau referred to
in section 1 of article XV of said chapter 426. Said
appointment being without term and to commence
February 2, 1928.
