WHEREAS: The Village of Edina was founded on December 12, 1888, by a vote of its residents; and

WHEREAS: The Edina Centennial Commission has coordinated a year full of Centennial activities which reflect on the past, celebrate the present, and look to the future; and

WHEREAS: The people who live and work in Edina have long established a pattern of involvement, cooperation, and commitment to the community; and
