


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I,
G. A. Youngquist, attorney general of the state of

by statute, and particularly by authority of section

constitute and appoint CHARLES E. PHILLIPS, of
Mankato, Minnesota, to be an assistant attorney general
