- WHEREAS: H. William Lurton is the National Chairman of the 1988 National Student-Parent Mock Election, which will be held on Thursday evening, November 3rd; and
- WHEREAS: The theme of the 1988 National Student-Parent Mock Election is "We The People: The Personal Responsibility By Which Democracy Lives;" and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Lurton has demonstrated this responsibility through accepting the National Chairmanship of the National Student-Parent Mock Election, which seeks to turn around the apathy that leaves America with the lowest voter turnout of any of the world's democracies; and


in Minnesota.


