



## Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Kandiyohi Bottled Water Company purifies already-processed city feed water by putting it through 11 additional steps, including filtration, steam distillation, ultra-violet light and ozonation, and then re-introduces selected minerals to enhance taste and nutritional value; and
- WHEREAS: Linda Traulich and Jerry Vogel, two Wilmar residents who had been observing the declining quality of drinking water since the early 70's, started Kandiyohi Bottled Water Company two years ago in Wilmar; and
- WHEREAS: The idea behind the company is that if single cleansing processes were partially effective in reducing contaminants, a combination of the best ones would come closest to producing perfectly clean water; and
- WHEREAS: Over 400 retail outlets carry Kandiyohi Bottled Water, which is the only process of its kind in the midwest; 90 stores receive Kandiyohi Premium Bottled Water in bulk form, delivered by stainless steel tankers; and
- WHEREAS: In October the company moved to a state-of-the-art, 20,000 square foot plant, employing 23 area residents; and
- WHEREAS: Kandiyohi Bottled Company contributes much to the State of Minnesota and to the Wilmar community;
- NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, November 15, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.
