



Proclamation

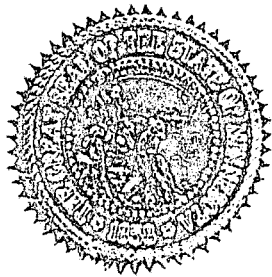
- WHEREAS: The number of people using Minnesota's food shelves and emergency and temporary shelters continues to increase each year; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota food shelves have been responsible for many significant contributions to the needy of our state; and
- WHEREAS: By using our foodshelves, the hungry of Minnesota are able to enjoy nutritious and satisfying meals; and
- WHEREAS: Minnesota food shelves must rely on generous donations and contributions from the Minnesota citizens in order to function, and continue operation; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota have a reputation of being kindhearted and generous people, and have always, in years past, kept Minnesota food shelves full through their large and benevolent donations;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim May 22-29, 1989 to be

MINNESOTA FOODSHELVES WEEK

in Minnesota, and urge the citizens of this state to contribute non-perishable food items to local food shelves.
