WHEREAS: Both the financial and charitable contributions of Minnesota bankers have helped nurture the dreams of Minnesota families; and

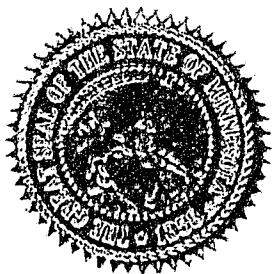
WHEREAS: Minnesota bankers have demonstrated for a century that they believe in the future of their state and fellow Minnesotans;
