WHEREAS: The Minnesota Bankers Association first convened January 10, 1889, to protect and

strengthen the state's financial system; and

WHEREAS: During the past 100 years Minnesota bankers have provided loans for homes, schools,

hospitals and education; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota bankers have helped the state's businesses, farms and communities prosper;

and

WHEREAS: Both the financial and charitable contributions of Minnesota bankers have helped

nurture the dreams of Minnesota families; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota bankers have demonstrated for a century that they believe in the future of

their state and fellow Minnesotans;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim January 10, 1988 to be

MINNESOTA STATE BANKING DAY

in Minnesota, in honor of the Minnesota Bankers Association.
