



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The new public library in Moorhead, Minnesota will be dedicated on October 23, 1988; and

WHEREAS: Public Libraries provide and house a treasure trove of books, magazines, art, audio and video materials; and

WHEREAS: Public Libraries are used by people of all ages to study and learn about the past, obtain information for the present, and to dream and plan for the future; and

WHEREAS: The city and people of Moorhead have had constructed a new public library building; and

WHEREAS: This significant accomplishment results from people working together at the local, regional, state and federal level; and

WHEREAS: Funding for this project came from generous individuals, local organizations, city tax funds, the Lake Agassiz Regional Library, and the federal Library Services and Construction Act; and

WHEREAS: All Minnesotans will benefit as this library building helps the residents of this area increase their effective use of library resources to obtain information that will promote personal growth, increased productivity and civic participation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 23, 1988 to be

MOORHEAD PUBLIC LIBRARY DAY

in Minnesota.
