WHEREAS: Millions of Americans need supplemental food assistance at some time during each month; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Food Bank Network, with Food Banks in Crookston, Grand Rapids, Hibbing, Marshall, Minneapolis, Rochester, St. Paul, Virginia and Fargo, North Dakota, highlights its yearlong efforts to feed the needy by observing National Food Bank Week November 6-12; and

WHEREAS: Second Harvest, America's largest food bank network which solicits and distributes nearly 400 million pounds of food to the needy each year, and The Minnesota Food Bank Network is committed to helping the needy in Minnesota;

NATIONAL FOOD BANK WEEK


in Minnesota, in recognition of the contribution of The Minnesota Food Bank Network to the fight to the fight to feed the needy in Minnesota.


