WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota has been awarded the honor of hosting the 1988 NCAA Division I Women's Volleyball Championship; and

WHEREAS: The Championship, held on December 15 and 17, 1988 at Williams Arena, will be nationally televised; and

WHEREAS: This is the first time a NCAA Division I Women's National Championship has ever been held in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The National Championship is the most significant women's event ever held at the University of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Amateur Sports Commission has determined that the Championship is Minnesota's premier sporting event of 1988; and

WHEREAS: Thousands of players, coaches and fans from across the country will come to Minnesota for the Championship;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week of December to be


