WHEREAS: The School of Dentistry at the University of Minnesota was founded in 1888 on the central idea that Dentistry is a branch of the healing arts; and

WHEREAS: The School of Dentistry has educated dentists and dental hygienists for the health and welfare of citizens; and

WHEREAS: The School of Dentistry had conducted research to advance the knowledge of the profession and improve the oral health of the public it serves; and

WHEREAS: The School of Dentistry opens its clinics to care for the citizens of our state; and

WHEREAS: The School of Dentistry provides continuing dental education so that our graduates can practice to the highest standards in their profession; and

WHEREAS: The School of Dentistry is committed to excellence in all aspects of teaching, research, and patient care;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the eighteenth day of November, 1988 to honor the Centennial of the School of Dentistry at the University of Minnesota.
