WHEREAS: Seniors have many excellent senior organizations offered to them such as the Metropolitan Senior Federation (MSF) which represents over 250 senior clubs, and 100,000 individual seniors in the metropolitan area, and offers many services, including housing, health services, travel and leisure, insurance and legal referral; and

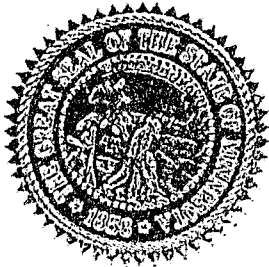
