WHEREAS: The Saint Paul Power Squadron is a locally constituted Squadron of the United States Power Squadrons; and

WHEREAS: The objects of the United States Power Squadrons are to establish high standards of skill in handling and navigation of water craft, to encourage the study of the science of navigation and small boat handling, to cooperate with the agencies of the United States Government charged with enforcement of the laws and regulations relating to navigation and to stimulate interest in activities which will tend to increase the effectiveness of our Army, Navy Coast Guard, and Merchant Marine; and

WHEREAS: Over three thousand people have taken the public boating class sponsored by the ${\it St.}$ Paul Power Squadron; and

WHEREAS: On November 11, 1988, the St. Paul Power Squadron will celebrate the 25th anniversary of its charter;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of November to be

in Minnesota, in honor of the 25th anniversary of the St. Paul Power Squadron's charter.
