WHEREAS: UNICEF's international message of goodwill and friendship manifests itself in clean water, good nutrition, immunization, and educational opportunity; and

WHEREAS: National UNICEF Day is an opportunity for every American to show support for UNICEF's admirable humanitarian service by being generous to UNICEF trick-or-treaters and participating in local UNICEF benefit activities;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 31, 1988 to be
