- WHEREAS: Sandy's determination and triumph have earned our respect; they now deserve our recognition;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of December 11-17, 1988 to be

in Minnesota on behalf of all people who triumphed despite disability or adversity.


