WHEREAS: Volunteers in Minnesota demonstrate concern, commitment and generosity of spirit by providing food for the hungry, educating the public about hunger and malnutrition, and advocating policies to eliminate domestic hunger; and

WHEREAS: Volunteers are the vital link between hungry people and the community's response, thereby forging bonds of support and concern between those in greatest need and those with greater resources; and

WHEREAS: Volunteers are the unsung individuals who work quietly and unselfishly to help the hungry and malnourished;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Gowarnor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second day of December, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.
