

## **Proclamation**

The school districts in Southwest and West Central Minnesota have a long history of WHEREAS: cooperation and leadership; and

These school districts have shown that they are dedicated to doing all they can to meet specific educational needs, provide necessary educational services and expand opportunities for their students; and WHEREAS:

These school districts created the idea of regional cooperatives, to perform WHEREAS: educational planning on a regional basis and provide educational programs and services through a joint effort of school districts, more efficiently and economically than individual school districts; and

These school districts petitioned the Minnesota legislature for authorization to WHEREAS: begin a regional educational cooperative, and in 1973, the legislature issued a grant for a pilot cooperative, which these school districts created, and called an "educational service area"; and

In 1976, based on the success of the pilot cooperative, which is now known as the Southwest and West Central Cooperative Service Unit, the Minnesota legislature authorized every region in the state to begin educational cooperatives, and issued administrative grants for their development; and WHEREAS:

Due to the spirit of cooperation and unity in the Southwest and West Central Minnesota area of Minnesota, especially in the area of education, today Educational Cooperative Service Units are an important part of our quality educational system in the State of WHEREAS: Minnesota:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim June 3, 1988 to be

COOPERATION FOR QUALITY EDUCATION DAY

in Minnesota.
