- WHEREAS: Hunger has reached epidemic proportions in our city, state, and our world; and
- WHEREAS: The National Student Campaign Against Hunger is a student-run organization to fight hunger; and
- WHEREAS: Students in Minnesota's colleges in the Twin cities, Duluth, St. Cloud, Moorhead, and Winona, along with students around the country, are joining forces to fight hunger and clean up their cities; and
- WHEREAS: This Great Hunger Cleanup will provide a sense of community and self-help which is needed in our area, while meeting the needs of those less fortunate; and
- WHEREAS: On Saturday, April 16, 1988, students from this area will be working at local community service projects while raising money for local and worldwide hunger coalitions; and
