WHEREAS: Augusta Strehlow, who is known to her family and many friends as Gussie, turned 100 years old on September 16, 1988; and

WHEREAS: Gussie Strehlow had three children, two of whom are still living, seven grandchildren, and thirteen great grandchildren; and

WHEREAS: Gussie made a living for herself and her family during the depression by wallpapering for people, and wallpapered much of Shakopee; and

WHEREAS: When Gussie was in her 60's she took a job as the salad and hors doeuvre cook at The Riviera Restaurant in Chanhassen; and

WHEREAS: Gussie retired when she was 81 years old, and lived in her own home until she was in her 90's, when she moved to a senior high rise apartment in Shakopee; and

WHEREAS: Gussie is a remarkable and deserving woman, and it is fitting to have a special day in her honor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, October 24, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.
