WHEREAS: Harvey Cushing, M.D., the author, won the Pulitzer Prize for his biography of Sir William Osler, M.D.; and

WHEREAS: Harvey Cushing, M.D. the physician, surgeon, soldier, author and scientist contributed greatly to the advancements of medical science and clinical practice and ultimately to humanity;
