- WHEREAS: Joseph R. Pavék was a hard-working bookkeeper, accountant, paint distributor, and sales manager between 1931 and 1945; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph R. Pavék, through outstanding management practices and a commitment to customer satisfaction, expanded his small business to a complete service to the auto body trade; and
- WHEREAS: Joseph R. Pavék established the first automotive warehouse serving the Upper Midwest in paint finishes, equipment and shop supplies; and

JOSEPH R. PAVEK DAY


in Minnesota.


