



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Mesaba Aviation, Inc. is a regional airline serving the hub airport of Minneapolis/St. Paul, and provides scheduled passenger and air freight service to 21 cities in Minnesota, Iowa, Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota and Wisconsin; and

WHEREAS: Mesaba Aviation operates as a Northwest Airlines Airlink, under a major marketing agreement, enabling the two carriers to work together in offering passengers connecting schedules, fares and marketing programs between the regional cities served by Mesaba and the major system served worldwide by Northwest; and

WHEREAS: Mesaba Aviation operates a fleet of six 48-passenger Fokker F27 jet props and seven 19-passenger Metro III jet props; and

WHEREAS: Mesaba Aviation has been conducting business as a Minnesota based company since 1944, and has provided scheduled airline service since 1973; and

WHEREAS: Mesaba Aviation today is one of the nation's major regional airlines, serving more Minnesota cities than any other carrier; and

WHEREAS: On Friday, April 22, 1988, Mesaba Aviation, Inc. will hold a dedication for its new maintenance base and general headquarters to be constructed this spring at the Minneapolis/St. Paul International Airport;
