



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The generation and disposal of solid waste has reached a crisis stage throughout the United States; and

WHEREAS: Millions of pounds of solid waste including glass items, which could be recycled and reduce waste reaching our landfills, are still being disposed of after a single use; and

WHEREAS: Anchor Glass Container Company provides an important service to the state as the only in-state end market for the glass recovered from Minnesota's waste stream; and

WHEREAS: Anchor Glass Container Company has recently added a sorting system to greatly increase its capacity for recycling glass beyond the current amount of glass available for recycling;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 24, 1988 to be

MINNESOTA GLASS RECYCLING DAY

in Minnesota.
