6* Notice is hereby given that Jack Lucdo of Virginia, Minn., filed in the General Land Office at Washington, D.C., on February 8th, 1928 an application for the survey of an island, which is located in the Northwest quarter of the Southeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ -SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section One (1), Township Sixty-four (64), North of Range Twenty (20), W.4.P.M., located about 650 feet from the nearest mainland to the west, and 1254 feet from the nearest mainland to the east, containing .38 of an acre of ground. The location of said island being as follows:- Beginning at meander corner No.3 on west side of bay at Pelican Lake on section line between Sections 1 and 12, Town 54, North of Range 20, W.4.P.M.; thence North 16 degrees east, thence north 16 degrees east a distance of 1450 feet to a post marked A.M.C. on the south side of said island.

That this parcel of land is unsurveyed according to the records in the General Land Office.
