WHEREAS: We are proud of the athletes from Minnesota, who represented our state and our nation at the 1988 Summer Olympic Games and Paralympic Games in Seoul, Korea; and

WHEREAS: All of these athletes achieved great success in making their dreams of Olympic and Paralympic competition a reality; and

WHEREAS: The thrill and honor of taking part in such an important international event far outweigh the number of medals won by our state's athletes; and

WHEREAS: Dave Krmpotich, who was born in Duluth, earned a silver medal in the rowing competition, showing his fighting spirit and excellent ability;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, November 10, 1988 to be
