



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: The Duluth Chapter of the American Red Cross was chartered in 1915; and
- WHEREAS: Red Cross chapter branches were subsequently chartered in Hibbing, Virginia and Grand Rapids; and
- WHEREAS: The Northland branches responded to the call of President Woodrow Wilson and exceeded all quotas in the delivery of money and supplies for American soldiers in World War I and, again, in World War II, exceeded the requests for support; and
- WHEREAS: Northland Chapter of the American Red Cross, encompassing Itasca, St. Louis, Cook, Lake and Douglas (WI) counties, has, year after year, for 75 years, continued to generously respond to those suffering from national disasters whether the need was in Minnesota, the United States or the world; and
- WHEREAS: Volunteers make it possible for the American Red Cross to collect and provide blood to the ill and injured, provide emergency assistance to disaster victims, and to respond to the emergency needs of armed forces personnel and their families and dependents; and
- WHEREAS: The chapter, through its thousands of skilled volunteers, provides water safety, plant safety and CPR training to the residents of the five county area;
