


ORDER REVOKING PROVISIONS OF EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER NINE AS TO  
THE TAKING OF MUSKRATS IN WASECA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, after investigation by the Commissioner of Game and Fish, it appears that the additional protection for muskrats in Waseca County provided by Executive Order Number Nine, dated January 25, 1928, is un-necessary,

THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby order that so much of said Executive Order Number Nine, as relates to the taking of muskrats in Waseca County be and the same is hereby revoked, and that the taking of muskrats in said county shall be permitted during the period from March 30th to April 18, 1928, both inclusive, as provided by Executive Order Number Eight, dated January 25, 1928, and the statutes in such case made and provided.
