The preservation of these prairies and landscapes is essential to maintain their beauty and usefulness for future generations; and WHEREAS:

Federal, state and local units of government have taken action to preserve and protect prairies; and WHEREAS:

Minnesotans should recognize the importance of prairies for preserving plants, birds WHEREAS:

The state of Minnesota has taken a leading role in innovative protection, prudent management and use of these prairie resources; WHEREAS:

NOW, THEREFORE, 1, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 13,

in Minnesota.
