



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The first New Brighton Squash Show was held in 1928, making this the 60th Annual Squash Show; and

WHEREAS: There seemed to be a need to continue the Squash Show because of community interest, and the idea of having the squash show in the area was due largely because of our large production of squash and pumpkins; and

WHEREAS: In 1950 the New Brighton Lions Club took over sponsoring the Squash Show; and

WHEREAS: The Lions Club acts for the betterment of the community; one year the Lions Club gave the proceeds of the Squash Show advertisements to the Mounds View High School for an electronic score board; for Minnesota flags to all of School District #621 - public and parochial and for sponsorship of the first ambulance in the New Brighton area, which was later taken over by the community;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, October 7, 1988 to be

in Minnesota.
