



Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Minnesota's Agricultural industry is an important source of a wide variety of high quality foods; and
- WHEREAS: Approximately 35 million dollars of food products, and 147 million dollars of dairy products are purchased locally by Minnesota schools; and
- WHEREAS: There are 1,828 schools participating in the School Lunch Program in Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: 473,000 school children derive one third of their daily nutritional requirements from this program; and
- WHEREAS: It is fitting we salute our youth, our School Lunch Program and our agricultural industry;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of January 9-13, 1988 to be

ALL MINNESOTA FOODS WEEK IN ALL
MINNESOTA SCHOOLS

and urge all schools of this State to participate in serving complete menus of food produced and processed in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this seventh day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-eight, and of the State the one hundred thirtieth.
