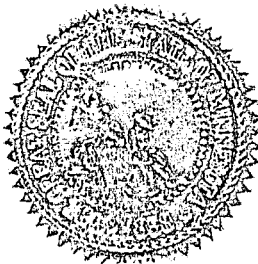
WHEREAS: A Smoke Free Generation curriculum will be taught throughout the State of Minnesota the third week of January, 1989;
