WHEREAS: On February 12, 1989, an opening ceremony or "birthday party" will kick-off the city's centennial celebration; and

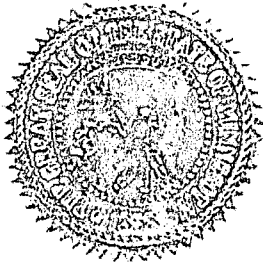
