WHEREAS: The city of Barnum was officially established on February 5, 1889; and

WHEREAS: The citizens of Barnum and the immediate area are proud of their rich century-long

heritage; and

WHEREAS: A book has been written and published depicting Barnum's progress and outlining that

heritage over the past 100 years; and

WHEREAS: On February 12, 1989, an opening ceremony or "birthday party" will kick-off the city's

centennial celebration; and

WHEREAS: A series of events, contests, displays, picnics and entertainment is scheduled in June

1989, coinciding with the city's annual Spring Fever Day's Festival, and honoring the

city's centennial;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich. Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the year 1989 to be

CENTENNIAL YEAR FOR THE CITY OF BARNUM

in Minnesota, in honor of the 100th anniversary of its origin.
