WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has a vested interest in creating a public/private partnership to help meet the needs of Minnesota's children and families; and

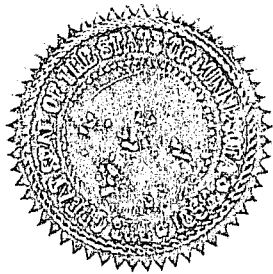
